

# MECHANICAL ASSISTANT

## THE COMPANY

August Robotics is an **international company** which builds application-specific robots to automate workflows for businesses. We believe in the potential for **humans and robots to collaborate and co-operate**, and we aspire to be at the forefront of the coming “robotics revolution”.

August Robotics recently **released its first robot**, an application-specific robot for the global trade show industry. The company will soon begin work on its next wave of **revolutionary robots** and is growing its team accordingly.

## THE ROLE

As a **Mechanical Assistant**, you will be a relatively junior member of the August Robotics team in Shenzhen, but you will be involved in a wide array of tasks, giving you the opportunity to embark on a steep learning curve and to develop your career swiftly.

Your primary responsibilities will be in the assembly and maintenance of August Robotics’ robots:

- a) **Assemble the company’s robots**, and assemble the constituent components of each robot, according to the training you will receive from our mechanical engineering team
- b) **Maintenance of the company’s robots**, keeping them clean and in good working order, and ensuring that all the components of the prototype robots are always kept in optimal condition
- c) **Categorise and organise** the components, parts and accessories in the company’s R&D workshop
- d) Assist your colleagues in preparing the company’s robots for **testing routines and procedures**, and assist the company’s testing engineers to carry out full-system robot tests
- e) **Mixing of paints**, assisting on **packaging and logistics** and other miscellaneous tasks and jobs

Additionally, as a member of a start-up company in which every member of staff is expected to **pitch in and help out**, your responsibilities will also include assisting with the completion of some administrative tasks.

The role will be based in August Robotics’ office in **Shenzhen**.

## YOUR SKILLS

You **must** show:

- A strong **interest in technology**, robotics and mechanical engineering
- An ability to follow **detailed technical instructions** carefully and conscientiously
- Excellent **organisational capabilities**
- Strong communication skills and teamwork capabilities
- Prior experience **assembling mechanical structures** (eg. electrical goods, cars, furniture, etc..), either at home or at work
- An ability to **foresee potential issues** and to ask for help when required
- A positive attitude and a **willingness to learn**
- Native level fluency in **Mandarin Chinese**

In addition to the above requirements, ALL of which you must demonstrate to be considered for this role, the following skills are helpful but not required:

- Experience working in a **factory, R&D centre or on a production line** assisting in the assembly of mechanical and electronic components
- Some understanding and/or experience with **mechanical engineering** principles and concepts

You should be **comfortable with ambiguity** and excited by the idea of working in an entrepreneurial culture. You should be **open to new experiences**, open to learning new things, and willing to jump in and lend a hand on a range of different issues and task when the need arises.

## REMUNERATION & PROCESS

An attractive monthly salary will be paid, and you will receive social security payments, including 5% housing fund, according to your full fixed monthly salary.

For applicants from outside of Shenzhen, accommodation may also be included in your remuneration package, subject to negotiation with the chosen candidate.
